Loving Heart, Peaceful Mind Meditation Retreat

March 27-30. Sensei Morris will lead a four-day meditation retreat, *Loving Heart, Peaceful Mind*, at the Gainesville Retreat Center, 1551 SE 51st Street, Gainesville.

This program includes intensive instruction and practice using the Brahma-Viharas meditations for self-exploration and improved relationships. Along with traditional practices described in the *Visudhimagga*, participants will also learn how to apply Naikan and Rational Buddhism (RB).

Costs at the center for food and accommodations varies. A nominal materials fee covers the cost of the *Loving Heart, Peaceful Mind* workbook and an MP3 disk of guided meditations. Dharma instruction is by donation.
